## What you will learn


- What does it take to be a leader in the real estate industry? The program provides  $\bullet$ both in-depth insights into the real estate investment industry, as well as leadership and management skills. In addition, throughout the program you will learn about concurrent and future challenges to leaders in the industry, such as inflation, increasing interest rates, climate risk, labor shortages, and technological change.
- Through faculty presentations, debates, case studies, interactive exercises, and small group discussions, you will acquire the required knowledge and skills to lead an organization active in the real estate market, globally or nationally.
- The program will include a number of visits to some of the most innovative and advanced buildings and ongoing development projects in Europe and North America. The visits will be led by the leading architect, project manager or building operators (e.g. The Edge in Amsterdam, Boston Seaport in Boston, Groothandelsgebouw in Rotterdam).
- The program will include panel discussions and guest lectures of some of the most inspiring leaders in the real estate industry.

### Timeline & Locations

The program consists of four modules, distributed across three teaching periods:

The schedule from Sunday to Saturday (7 full days) will include courses and site visits from 9AM to 5PM (including breaks).

Each day of the program includes multiple networking events as well as dedicated work and personal time.

The Global Real Estate Leaders Program consists of courses taught over 4 week-long modules. The program includes lectures by world-class real estate leaders who have had a formative and transformational impact in their field.

The selected candidates will be able to access the research community and have the opportunity to collaborate with faculty in different activities such as teaching, entrepreneurship activities or industry relationships of the center.


